

## Report of the Commission on the Future of Policing in Ireland

The Policing Authority welcomes the publication today of the report of the Commission on the Future of Policing in Ireland and looks forward to reading it in detail. The establishment of the Commission offered a significant opportunity to reflect and consider policing in Ireland. Today's report examines a broad range of topics, many of which were contained within the Authority's submission to the Commission including oversight structures, local policing, culture, performance management and training.
